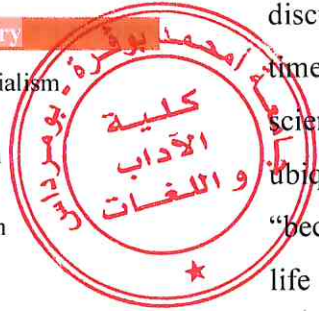



Philosophers and writers throughout the ages within the framework of different and successive civilizations have discussed the concept of freedom, as it is shaped every time in a new way parallel to social, cultural and scientific developments. Human existence is a real ubiquity of transformation and change from “being” to “becoming”. Without this transformation in being, human life would seem purposeless and stagnant. The philosophical aspects of being indicate that it is inseparable from the ontological essence of Man. The issues of being and becoming have evolved along the roots of many identity questions and freedom of action while expressing individual struggles for fulfillment of self, existence and personality.

Over the course of human history, the definitions of freedom, and what it meant to be free have evolved. Freedom, according to critics, is the autonomy of one's choices from any control by a deity or previously held beliefs or ideals. Then this illustration of the inextricable interconnectedness between the existence of man and his moral responsibility has been debated. The aim of this conference is to renew interest in the notion of freedom which enabled humans to move from a state of being to that of becoming. It looks into the re-conceptualization of the idea of freedom in modernity and postmodernity through manifold lenses as human beings' freedom is determined by new outer and inner factors.



It also investigates freedom, being and becoming as indistinguishably allied by bridging the gap between literary and philosophical perspectives.

The reconstruction and the reform of the notion of freedom in relation to being and becoming must be then re-appropriated to the new scientific data, social developments, natural disasters and humanitarian crises. Prospective participants are encouraged to contribute to and help shape the conference through submissions of their research abstracts on the following axes
